Open The Conversation: Share something good from this week.

Key Scripture: Read the following together.

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Hebrews 13:8 NKJV

- 1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
- 2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose one question to start the conversation, move onto others if time allows.

- How does the truth that Jesus is unchanging impact your personal relationship with Him? How has He been faithful to You? Reflect on how His unchanging nature strengthens your trust in Him, especially during challenging times.
- In what areas of your life do you find yourself seeking new beliefs or trends, rather than being rooted in the timeless truth of who Jesus is? Consider how you might refocus your searching to center more on the unchanging nature of Christ.
- How does the idea of offering a "sacrifice of praise" shape your understanding of worship? Share ways you can offer praise and gratitude to God, even when you don't feel like it, and how that sacrifice reflects your devotion to Him.
- What does it mean for the church to live with an eternal mentality, as mentioned in verses 13-14? How can we as a group encourage each other to focus on eternal values, especially when facing trials or rejection?
- Why is the idea of submitting to authority and praying for leaders emphasized in the passage (vv. 17-19)? How can we practically support our church leaders and church body and pray for them as a community, ensuring the spiritual health of the church? Share any testimonies you have witnessed within the church as an answer to your prayers.

Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.
