**Open The Conversation:** Share something good from this week.

**Key Scripture: Read the following together.** 

9 Believers in humble circumstances ought to take pride in their high position. 10 But the rich should take pride in their humiliation—since they will pass away like a wild flower. 11 For the sun rises with scorching heat and withers the plant; its blossom falls and its beauty is destroyed. In the same way, the rich will fade away even while they go about their business.

## James 1:9-11 NKJV

- 2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

## Start Sharing: Choose one question to start the conversation, move onto others if time allows.

- Where have you placed your identity and sense of worth—on temporary things like status or success, or on eternal things like your relationship with Jesus?
   Share a testimony of a time when God realigned your identity to your eternal identity in Jesus.
- When you face temptation, do you try to fight it by focusing on the sin—or by deepening your love for God?
- Do you live with the awareness that every good and perfect gift in your life is from God—and how are you expressing gratitude for those gifts?
- What are some practical ways we can shift our focus from resisting sin to pursuing a deeper love for Jesus in our daily lives?
- James contrasts the path of temptation (desire → sin → death) with God's path
  of truth and life. What helps you stay anchored to truth when you feel pulled by
  your desires or the world's messages?
