Open The Conversation: Share something you are looking forward to this year!

Key Scripture: Read the following together.

13 Then Moses said to God, “Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they say to me, ‘What is His name?’ what shall I say to them?” 14 And God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’ ” 15 Moreover God said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: ‘The Lord God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations.’ ”

Exodus 3:13-15

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose one question to start the conversation, move onto others if time allows.

- In this message we focused on God's name Yahweh which tells us He is a God of covenant and relationship. How does knowing God this way interject with your life?
- Bondage keeps us from knowing and experiencing God. The Israelites held onto their bondage because it was familiar and brought them comfort. What bondages might you be holding onto because they bring comfort?
- Where is God calling you to that is unknown or uncomfortable? What will you have to surrender to know Him intimately and follow Him closely?
- Share a testimony of a time God revealed who He is to you and how that changed your perspective and made an impact in your life.

Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.
