

## **Names of God: Soon and Coming King**

**Open The Conversation:** What's something you are currently looking forward to right now?

**Key Scripture:** Read the following together.

*20 He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly."*

*Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!*

*21 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.*

*Revelation 22:20-21*

**Start Sharing:** Choose one question to start the conversation, move onto others if time allows.

- What does "putting on Christ" look like in your everyday life—and where are you still tempted to "do your own thing"? Is there something the Lord has already given you that you've been hesitant or resistant to fully embrace?
- Are you more focused on watching the world around you, or on watching Jesus Himself? What has been capturing your attention lately, and is it drawing you closer to Him or slowly dulling your spiritual readiness?
- In the parables about readiness (the wedding garment and the ten virgins), what warnings stand out to you most—and why do you think Jesus emphasized preparation so strongly? How can we help one another stay ready without living in fear?
- What are some practical ways we can, as a community, stay "filled with oil" and keep our lamps burning? What rhythms, relationships, or practices help us remain spiritually alert and responsive to the Holy Spirit?

**Start Praying:** Pray together and for one another.

*"Heavenly Father, as we fix our eyes on You, help us to keep our attention on You in the day to day. We pray for ourselves, and all believers, to be alert and ready for your return. We choose to live with eternity in mind and honor You with our lives. Amen."*
