

Celebrating 10 Years of Laundry Love

Open The Conversation: Share about a time you felt loved.

Key Scripture: Read the following together.

7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 8 He who does not love does not know God, for God is love. 9 In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. 10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

1 John 4:7-11

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose one question to start the conversation, move onto others if time allows.

During service on Sunday we spent our time celebrating 10 years of Laundry Love, a ministry where we serve others by paying for their laundry. Today's questions will be focused on loving and serving others.

- Think of a time when someone showed the love of God to you. How did that impact your life? How did God show up for you?
- Share about a time when you showed God's love to others. How were you blessed? How did God show Himself to you?
- Share about a time you went out of your comfort zone to share the love of Jesus. What happened? How did God work in your heart?
- Share about a time when you experienced the love of God towards you the most intimately. How did that change you?

Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.
